



# Where Have I Heard That?

Ever found yourself humming a classical tune and wondering, "Where have I heard that?" Two pieces featured in our upcoming *Fantasia Favorites* concert —Modest Mussorgsky's *Night on Bald Mountain* and Amilcare Ponchielli's *Dance of the Hours*—have permeated popular culture in remarkable ways.



### Night on Bald Mountain

Mussorgsky's dramatic composition, known for its dark and swirling melodies, has become a go-to soundtrack for the eerie and otherworldly. It made a powerful impression in the original *Fantasia* film and has since been used in American Halloween specials, theme park attractions, and even *The Simpsons Treehouse of Horror IV*, where it underscored a climactic moment with its unmistakable sense of dread and excitement.

### Dance of the Hours

Ponchielli's light-hearted ballet has long delighted audiences with its graceful and playful themes. It became widely recognized in American pop culture thanks to Allan Sherman's 1963 hit parody, *Hello Muddah, Hello Fadduh* (A Letter from Camp), and has made appearances in everything from *The Carol Burnett Show* to television commercials, often used for comedic contrast—pairing elegance with absurdity. One memorable example? A dancing hippo and alligator duo in *Fantasia*, capturing imaginations for generations.

As we celebrate the 85th anniversary of the original release of *Fantasia*, we invite you to experience the music live in all its vivid color and emotional depth. Join us for an evening where timeless classics meet the memories they've helped create.
